

TRANSFORM YOUR INDUSTRIAL PROCESSES THROUGH

ENERGY-EFFICIENCY IMPROVEMENTS

Save on Energy's Industrial Energy Efficiency Program (IEEP) supports industrial customers across Ontario in improving their industrial processes and implementing system optimization projects. The IEEP offers organizations up to \$5 million in financial incentives for each large, complex industrial energy-efficiency project accepted into the program.

Reduced electricity usage

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

The IEEP provides incentives to qualifying industrial participants over three competitive rounds of funding in 2022 and 2023. In each round, participant applications will be ranked on the electricity savings their projects can achieve cost-effectively, among other criteria. The organizations with the highest-ranked applications will be eligible to receive funding for their project(s).

Get up to 75% of eligible project costs

Stack incentives from non-IESO programs

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Owners and/or operators of an industrial facility in Ontario; or
- Third-party applicants with the authority to implement a project at an industrial facility in Ontario





WHAT TYPES OF PROJECTS ARE ELIGIBLE?









- Must involve an electricity energy-efficiency improvement applied to, or in support of, an industrial process.
- Must achieve a minimum of 2,000 MWh of annual electricity savings, and represent a reduction of at least 15% from the baseline electricity use within the project boundary.
- Multiple projects may be included in a single application. Each project must achieve a minimum electricity savings of 500 MWh per year, with the total application achieving a minimum of 2,000 MWh in annual electricity savings.
- Must use commercially available technology as further described in the program eligibility rules.
- Must be in service within three years of the contract date, or by December 31, 2026, whichever is earlier.

Note: Lighting and power generation projects are not eligible for IEEP incentives. Waste energy recovery projects are eligible, provided that the waste is created on site.

APPLICATION TIMELINES

There will be two rounds of funding in 2023. Applications for the previous round closed on March 15.

• For the final round of funding, applications must be received by 11:59 p.m. ET on August 15, 2023.

*Participants deemed eligible will be invited to submit a detailed application with an Measurement and Verification (M&V) plan by 11:59 p.m. on March 31, 2023. The IESO will notify successful applicants by Ω 2 end.
